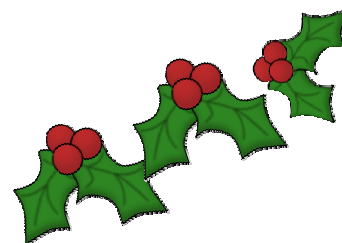


Christmas:
