



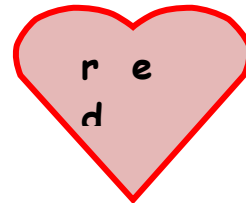
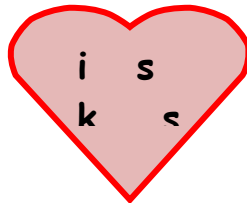

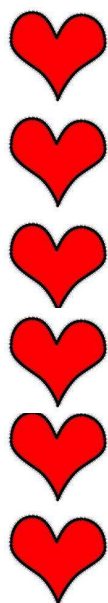

Saint Valentine's Day, commonly shortened to Valentine's Day, is a observed on February 14 honoring one or more early Christian named Saint Valentine. It is traditionally a day on which express their love for each other by presenting flowers, offering confectionery, and sending cards (known as "valentines"). The day first became associated with love in the circle of Geoffrey Chaucer in the High Middle Ages, when the tradition of courtly love flourished. It was first by Pope Gelasius I in 496 AD, and was deleted from the General Roman Calendar of saints in 1969 by Pope Paul VI.

Modern Valentine's Day symbols include the heart-shaped outline,, and the figure of the Cupid. Since the 19th century, handwritten valentines have given way to mass-produced greeting
